

Facilitation Questions to Ask

1. Would your group, or maybe you benefit from having an objective, third party manage the process? Might this contribute to a more acceptable and collaborative outcome?
2. Are there strong opinions, perceptions and differing views on the “facts”? Would someone from the outside help sort this out?
3. Do you need to be involved in the discussion and decision making process, not managing the group dynamics?
4. Would it be helpful if someone were there to make certain everyone’s voice is heard? Everyone’s opinion acknowledged?
5. Might your group need someone to push toward collaboration and agreement?
6. Is it important to have a written summary as we go along, so we don’t slide backwards or forget what we’ve already agreed upon?
7. Do we need someone to make certain our choices are clear, measurable and action orientated?
